



# H.R. 5620 & S. 3149: True Equity Act

## BILL SUMMARY

This Act may be cited as the “Transformational Reforms and Updates to Ensure Educational Quality and Urgent Investments in Today’s Youth Act of 2019” or the “TRUE EQUITY Act”. Congress finds the following: (1) The fate of our Nation and the opportunities it creates for our children and grandchildren to enjoy successful careers and rewarding lives depends on the quality, equal access, and effectiveness of pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade education in every local school district across the country. (2) Our education systems must prepare students to compete in an interconnected, global economy. (3) Despite the current combinations of Federal, State, and local funding and innovative educational policies.
